Proceedings:

1. Introductions: each of the participating organisations introduced themselves and their work.
2. Remit of the organisation: there was a discussion on what would be the purpose of the organisation. The following key points were agreed:
 - To have a means of communication and sharing so that organisations were not working in isolation when there is expertise available in the region.
 - Agreed to use the Slack channel in preference to emails.
 - To have a repository of international standards and guidelines that can be shared to help organisations in the region: the idea of putting in place an organisational website to hold these documents was discussed.
 - To examine the idea of putting in place archival standards/guidelines that reference international standards but that are specifically tailored to art archives (especially contemporary art/new media).
 - Discussion on the desirability of a regular conference.
 - Agreed that meeting participants would examine their networks and invite other relevant bodies to join the organisation.
3. Structure of the organisation: there was a discussion about the two main options for an organisational structure, a looser association without a legal entity, or an organisation that is incorporated in a jurisdiction, with a legal identity, accounts etc.
 - Agreed that it would be good to work towards a more formal, incorporated organisation.
4. Financing of the organisation: agreed that the examination of this would be done alongside the examination of the best structure for the organisation.
5. Formation of working groups: agreed to form two working groups
 - Group 1: research on possible communication channels with members, website and resources sharing, and short-term issues. Angharad McCarrick and Elaine Lim are the initial members of this group.

- Group 2: research on constitutions, organisation setup and long-term issues. Farah Wardani, Kevin Forkan, and Alan Yiu are the initial members of this group.
 - Noted that the group memberships are open to anyone else who wishes to contribute.
 - Group conversations will take place in channels on the overall Slack channel and will be viewable by all (not just group members).
6. Name of the organisation: it was suggested and provisionally agreed that the name of the organisation would be Art Libraries and Archives Network Asia (ALANA).
7. Next meeting and meeting schedule:
- Next meeting likely to be a fully virtual meeting, date to be agreed but probably late April.
 - Ambition to hold four meetings a year, mostly virtual although some may be hosted.

3. Create a poll to understand members' needs (Angharad)
